PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Our winter projects on the golf course have been largely completed with additional sand traps being converted to the "new" drainage designs. Holes 2, 5 and 11 have been completed this year. We have also installed new grass surfaces on the tees on holes 3 and 12, and we have expanded the ladies and men's gold tees on number 17 and installed the new grass variety. This new grass product will recover well from divots and resist the summer stresses much better than the previous surfaces. We expect these tees to be open in April.

The spring opening and work day at the waterfront and our flag raising ceremony will take place in the next few weeks. Please check our calendar to attend these opportunities to assist and enjoy our opening this year. The Pool committee is also organizing a fun workday opening to get the pool ready for the summer activities. These opportunities will hit your email box and calendar soon.

In case you missed it, we have a new Executive Chef at the club, Michael Quattrucci. Mike will bring a great deal of experience to our kitchen as he has been Executive Chef at other clubs and restaurants over his 25+ years of experience. He will make a great addition to our staff and we are sure you will enjoy his imagination in the dining offerings. Please take a moment to say hello and welcome Michael to CRYCC.

Work continues on our outdoor patio project as we level and raise the outdoor dining area and expand dining to serve 40 people on the patio. The new pavers and wall products have been ordered, and we are cautiously optimistic the project will be completed during April. The golf season opens with a golf dinner on April 6th followed by our Opening Day Tournament on April 9th. These should be fun events and are open to all golf members. I mentioned at the March Board meeting that we will be conducting a completely new look at a budget. As you can imagine, the budget that was set in October and passed at the November shareholders meeting did not foresee the abrupt changes in the general economy. Because we need to have a clear picture in order to properly prepare our monthly forecasts, I will be going over the 2022 budget with all department heads and the Finance Committee to make sure that we are on solid footing going forward.

FROM THE PRO - DAN PHILIPPON, PGA

By the time you read this, we will have been in the season for Posting Scores for two weeks. As a reminder, please post your scores on the date you played either through the GHIN mobile app or at www.GHIN.com. Contact me or Chris in the Golf Shop if you have any questions or if you need to get set up for a handicap. As the 2022 golf season has begun, this is a good time to remind everyone to observe the daily "Best Practices" to keep our golf course in pristine condition and our pace of play brisk!

On the Golf Course

Fix Ball Marks on Greens

- Repaired ball marks recover in a few days and leave smooth surfaces.
- Unrepaired take weeks to recover and leave bumpy, discolored, and scarred surfaces.

Replace Divots or Fill with Sand & Seed Mix

- Unrepaired take weeks to recover which adds extra costs to maintain.

Rake Bunkers

- Enter and exit the bunker at the low side.
- Raking disturbed areas leaves fair playing conditions for other players.

Remove Your Broken Tee

- Removing your broken tee eliminates the potential of damaging tee mowers.

Riding Cart Rules

- Know and follow the cart rules of the day.
- Keep all wheels on the cart paths.
- Keep carts 20 yards from greens when not on a cart path.
- Keep carts on paths near greens and tee areas.
- Observe areas marked "No Carts" or "Cart Path Only." Please keep push carts off greens, fringes, and tees.

5 Tips to Improve Your Pace of Play

1. Play ready golf by who is ready and not who has the honor or is away.
2. When driving a cart, drop players off and then drive to your ball. Do not wait for them to hit and then drive to your ball.
3. Play a provisional ball when it is likely yours is lost.
4. Study the line of your putt when another is playing.
5. Putt until you hole your ball, making sure you do not step on another player's line.

The "Golf Week at a Glance" emails started on March 20th and will continue each week throughout the season. These emails, sent out on Sunday, let you know the events for the current week and those coming up in the next 30 to 60 days. To make signing up for events easier, I include links that take you directly to the sign-up page on the Club website. Take a look at the notices I included for the events coming up in April, including **Neil Brayton's Skill Shot Challenge**. All are welcome even if you don't participate in the Skills Challenges! POOL NEWS

The Pool Committee is excited for the upcoming season and has been busy the last few weeks beginning to plan for reopening. Below is some preliminary information pertaining to the anticipated pool opening schedule, pool programming, and some important pool rules to be aware of. We will send more information in the May issue of the CRYCC newsletter in addition to CRYCC pool email blasts.

Opening Schedule: The CRYCC pool will open Memorial Day weekend (**Saturday, May 28 - Monday, May 30**) from 9am -10am (adults only) and from 10am-7pm (open to all patrons), barring any unforeseen circumstances. Weekday hours until we open full time will be determined based on staffing; this information will be determined next month.

Pool Programming: Interested in aerobics classes, swim lessons, family fun/adult socials, and any other activities? We are working on creating a pool programming schedule for the summer and would love member input to do so! **Please complete our CRYCC Pool Programming Feedback Survey by clicking on a link found in CRYCC pool blasts or on the CRYCC website.**

Swim Tests: Our swim test policy will be in effect when we open. Similar to years past, any patrons and guests under the age of 18 who wish to swim in deep water (higher than chest deep) will be required to take and pass a swim test. The swim test will comprise of the following skills:

- Individual entering the water feet first and completely submerging
- Individual must float or tread water for one minute with head remaining above the water
- Individual must swim on front a minimum of 25 yards without stopping or hanging onto the wall or lane rope
- Individual must exit the pool by pulling self up and over the side or using the ladder

Any individuals who do not pass the swim test must remain in the shallow end of the pool. **Additionally, all non-swimmers 4 feet and under must wear CRYCC approved flotation devices in the water and must be directly supervised by and within arm's reach of a responsible adult 18 years or older at all times.** CRYCC approved flotation devices include a swim bubble, puddle jumper, and a lifejacket. Infants can be placed within an infant float.
